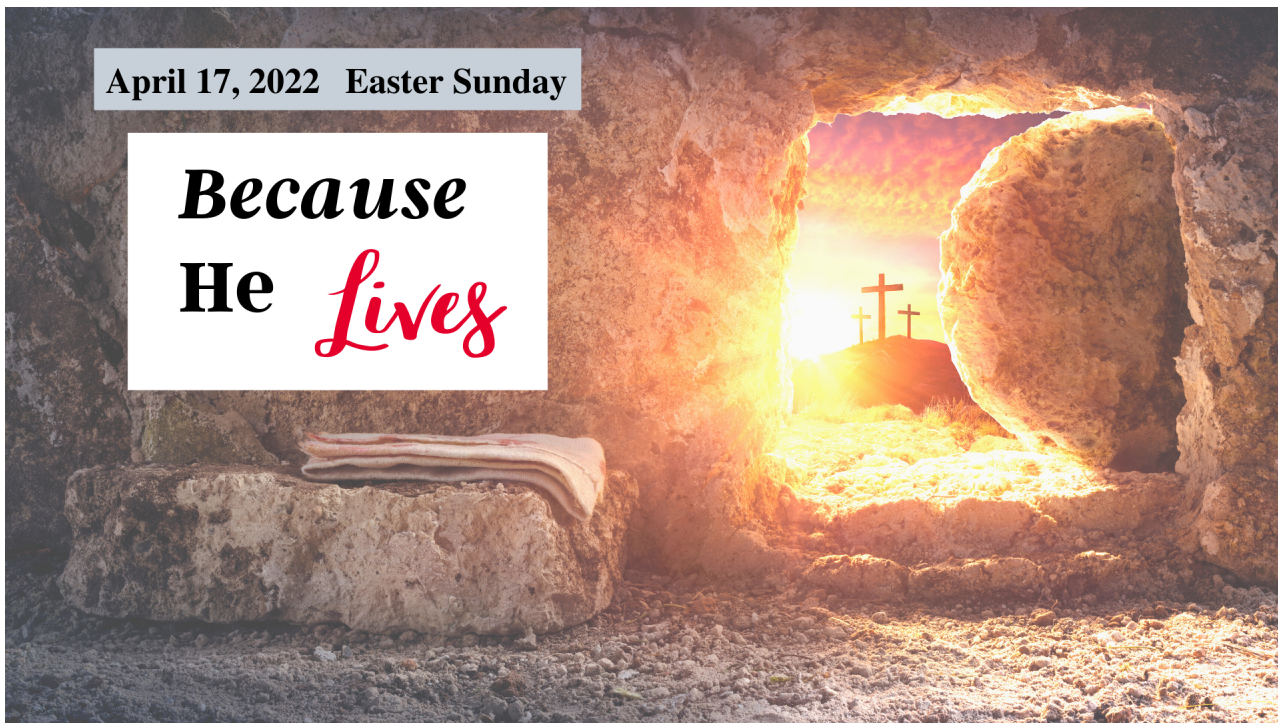

L: On this day of the Resurrection, we affirm,
