


SATURDAY NIGHT-Easter Preparation APRIL 11, 2020



Pre-service preparation/notes***

You are urged to spend time in preparation before this Easter Holy Communion service.

Bishop Park has stated that bread or crackers, juice or wine could be used during Communion.

Spend time in prayer as individuals and families on Saturday night in preparation.

Include your children/grandchildren/youth in this preparation.

Read PSALM 51:1-12 and spend time asking, "What must I confess to the Lord for his forgiveness as I come to His Table on Easter morning?"

Questions for reflection:

Does sin hurt God's heart? Why?

Could our sins hurt others?

Jesus loves you and died for your sin. Have you asked Jesus to forgive you? Do you know him as your Lord and Savior?

Participating in a Communion service without the true confession of our sins, is like trying to enjoy the most beautiful sunrise with our eyes closed. We might feel the warmth of the sun but never experience the glow of its light.

"If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

God loves you and wants to forgive you. He wants you to experience the glow of this love and light! All you need to do is ask.

If you or your children/grandchildren wish to invite Jesus into your hearts, here is a prayer you can pray: Lord Jesus, thank you for loving me not only when I was good, but even when I was bad. I am sorry for hurting you by thinking wrong thoughts, speaking wrong words and doing things that hurt others and you. Thank you for dying for my sins on the cross. Please forgive my sins. Come into my heart, Lord Jesus. I want to be a new person by your power. I want to live all my life for you and love you with all my heart. Amen.

And so, in remembrance of these your mighty acts in Jesus Christ, we offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in union with Christ's offering for us, as we proclaim the mystery of faith. Supporting our Troops.

The Uber's son-in-law and daughter are stationed at Ft. Gordon in Georgia. He is commander of the young troops who come for basic training or for further training. There are concerns about these young troops that are being quarantined 2-4 in a room, with little outside interaction. Depression and occasional suicide is not uncommon for these young people. Meals and help offered by our New Cumberland Senior's center.

Benefits ANYONE 60 and older. Bagged lunches are served every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 11:30 - noon (only one half hour). In order to receive these bags they must be ordered the day before by 11 a.m. For instance, if you want the Monday lunch, you must place your reservation by 11 Friday morning. There is a gentleman who brings leftovers to the Senior Center on Wednesdays that he brings from the Veterans Food Bank. Those items are also distributed on Wednesdays but it is first come, first served. On Thursdays they receive bread from Giant and clients may have one bread and one sweet along with their bagged lunch. Whenever there are extras of anything they're added to their bagged lunch.

The phone number to call to make your reservation is 717-774-0409. You must leave your name and phone number and how many lunches. These are catered lunches.
