This year we are incorporating a hybrid model where you can pack a shoe box or contribute. Please make your check to Trinity UMC Church and in the memo line indicate Operation Christmas Child. If you wish to pack a shoe box, you may use one of your choosing or pack one that is provided on the display table. If you wish to wrap your shoe box, please make sure that the lid and the box are wrapped separately. There is a \$10 shipping and processing fee that should be put in an envelope and put in the shoe box. On the display table, you will also find a flyer to indicate the gender and the age of the child that you choose. This should be affixed to the lid of the shoe box. There are further guidelines if you wish to go on to Operation Christmas Child that will explain what to pack and not to pack as well as a brochure on the display board that will give you this information. This program delights children from more than one hundred countries where local partners deliver the boxes along with a message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. For some children, it is the first time that they have received a gift and some go on to participate in the follow up discipleship program, the Greatest Journey.
